

**BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (LIME TREET WAY FOOTWAY TO LINDEN WAY, PORTHCRAWL) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER) ORDER 2021**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council as the Highway Authority for Porthcawl in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) has made an Order which will temporarily introduce the restriction set out in the schedule below. The Order is necessary due to insufficient width of footway to maintain pedestrian access during gas main replacement and is in the interest of public safety. The Order will come into force on the 12/04/2021 and it is anticipated will be operative from 12/04/2021 to 23/04/2021, or until such time as the works are completed, and will continue in force for a maximum period of 6 months.

**Schedule**

1. No person shall cause any person to proceed in Lime Tree Way footway to Linden Way, Porthcawl, a distance of approximately 30 metres

The restriction shall however only apply at such time and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

The alternative route is via Lime Tree Way, Rowan Drive, Birch Walk, Danygraig Avenue, Linden Way and reverse in opposite direction
